

Karin Alton

Karin Alton obtained a degree in Zoology at the University of Nottingham, followed by a PhD in Entomology. She has studied aphids, tephritid flies, hoverflies, and bugs and beetles of lowland grasslands. For the past 10 years Karin has worked as a Research Fellow at the Laboratory of Apiculture and Social Insects (LASI) at the University of Sussex on various projects involving honey bees and other pollinators. She also runs the research group's outreach programme. Karin is also a beekeeper, and is especially keen to encourage children to take up an interest in all things nature!

Karin is a Director of FlowerScapes Ltd, where she gives advice about how to enhance green spaces for pollinators and people alike and provides a selection of specially designed flower seed mixes to keep both groups happy!
